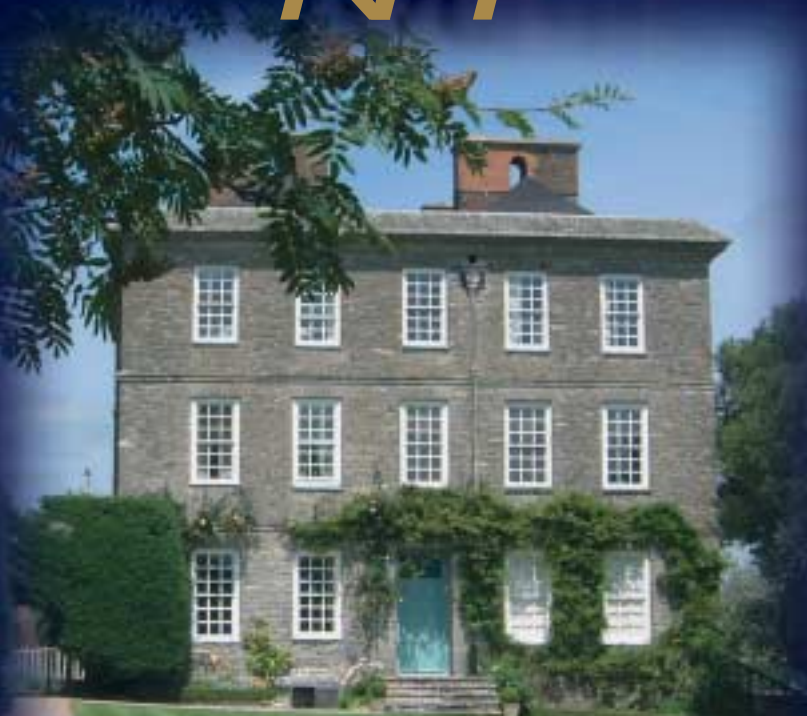

# Kingston House

**A**s one of the finest surviving examples of early eighteenth century architecture in Britain today, Kingston House and its' grounds are packed with history.

The House is rated Five Diamonds  
– Gold Award.



**K**ingston provides outstanding accommodation in three period suites on the first floor of the house, (referred to in 18th century architecture as the piano nobile).

The bedrooms have all been sympathetically restored to reflect the style and luxury of the age in which the house was built.

# The Blue Suite

The re-creation of an original 1735 Angel Tester bed forms the Centrepiece of a room steeped in history. This suite is indeed a memorable and romantic experience.



The beautiful panelled bathroom with 15<sup>th</sup> to 17<sup>th</sup> century carving, the elegant setting of the principal eighteenth century bedroom of the house, together with the original china closet.





## The Red Suite

The Red Suite exudes warmth from the moment that one steps into the room. The wallpaper design is from 1740, as are the Austrian blinds echoing the tastes of the time to perfection.



The bedroom leads through to an elegant en suite bathroom. The bed canopies, which have been in the house since the 19th century, have been restored and hung with red and gold silk. Also available as a twin bed room.

# The Green Room

The Green Room is dominated by its' magnificent bed, which was made for the Room in 1830.

The wallpapers, fabrics and furniture are all true to the period, with the colours of the room being taken from a Wedgwood tureen, part of a service in daily use at that time.

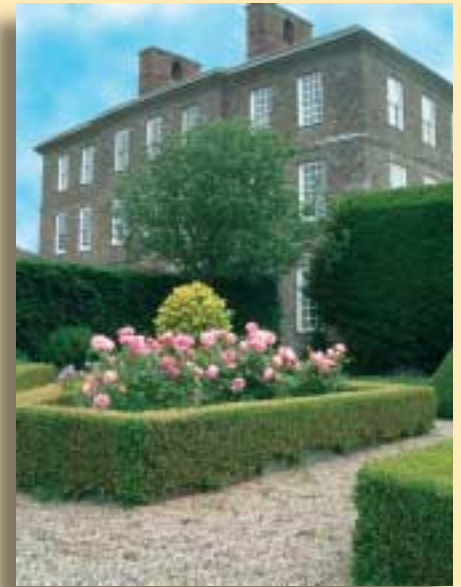
